<b>Sinopsis</b>	<p>The science of this course is in its systematic approach to Deception Detection in an investigation, interview, or interrogation. Through an effective understanding of Nonlinguistic communication and the verbal language of deception. Proven in countless situations through, Observation While Listening, (The OWL mode to detecting deception) together with investigative techniques, questioning skills &amp; strategies, effective perceptive tools, and understanding of Nonlinguistic communication and the verbal language of deception one can get to the truth successfully.</p> <p>To get to the truth, the course teaches participants to overcome beliefs that people will not lie, teaches them how to overcome their involuntary reliance on behavioral myths, how to overcome their communication difficulties, and gives them the knowledge to overcome their inescapable biases that can prejudice their chance to a correct judgment of truth during an interview, investigation or interrogation.</p> <p>It's a truth that behavioral clues to lies do continually provide absolute evidence of crimes but it does alert us to further investigation and scientific analysis, where we can then uncover lies and reveal evidence of the truth, systematically rather than what most people have been doing speculatively.</p> <p>Participants attending this course would then learn two other risks in detecting deceit, disbelieving (judging a truthful person to be lying) and believing-a-lie (judging a liar to be truthful). They would further learn that the absence of signs of deceit is also not the truth, because some people don't leak.</p> <p>The same is true that a sign of deceit is not always evidence of lying, as some people appear guilty even when they are truthful. Yet, participants would learn that more than one indicator, that is, a cluster, within five seconds after a strategic and effective question is asked or a stimulus is given, the result is often the truth that the suspect is lying.</p> <p>These 5 days advanced course on Nonlinguistic Communication &amp; Deception Detection Skills teaches participants to interpret Nonlinguistic communication correctly and methodically and to learn the verbal language of deception effectively. They would also learn skills to questioning strategies and the know-how of investigative interviewing skills that when practiced and applied would certainly succeed in detecting deception as good investigators, interviewers, and interrogators.</p>
