- A professional qualification that is recognised as being equivalent to (i) above; or
- A pass at Level 7 Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) assessment by Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA); or
- Other qualifications approved by the Senate.
- All international candidates graduated from degree programmes whereby English is not the medium of instruction must have obtained a minimum of 550 for the TOEFL Paperbased test or 80 for the Internet-based test, or IELTS Band 6.0, or MUET Band 5.0.
