RENEWAL OF A STUDENT PASS BY THE MALAYSIAN IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT UPON EXPIRY

1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 EMGS had previously notified (*Updates Clarification for International Students and Institutions on application processing during and post the Movement Control Order period dated 18th July 2020) all education institutions that the Malaysian Immigration Department is allowing international students to continue renewing their student pass if it expired after 1st February 2020. This facility was implemented as these students were unable to travel to Malaysia because of global border closures due to the Covid19 pandemic worldwide.*
- 1.2 The Malaysian Immigration Department has now issued a circular (Ref: IM.101/HQ-G/1130/1/1-2JLD.16 (62)) dated 23rd February 2023 rescinding this facility as there is no longer any travel restrictions imposed due to the Covid 19 pandemic.

2. IMPLEMENTATION

- 2.1. Beginning 1st April 2023, all international students with an expired student pass will not be allowed to enter Malaysia using a social visit pass and renew their student pass. Existing international student in Malaysia will also not be allowed to renew their student pass once it has expired.
- 2.2. These students will be required to apply a new application and obtain a new eVisa Approval Letter (eVAL).
- 2.3. Kindly note that the Malaysian Immigration Department may allow certain international students to renew their student pass if the current pass expiry has not lapsed for more than 3 months. The decision is entirely under the discretion of the Malaysian Immigration Department.
- 2.4. EMGS would remind Education Institutions that the Malaysian Immigration Department allows International Students to renew their student pass 3 months prior to the expiry.
